

At time of the nomination and election, or appointment, each trustee will be a school district elector of his or her district and a resident of the trustee zone from which he or she is nominated and elected, or appointed.

Each trustee will qualify for and assume office at the annual meeting of the school district next following the election, or, if appointed, at the regular meeting of the board next following such appointment.

An oath of office will be administered to each trustee, whether elected, re-elected or appointed. The oath may be administered by the clerk, or by a trustee of the district, and records of the district will show such oath of office to have been taken, and by who administered, and will be filed with the official records of the district.
