

It is the policy of this district to have graduating seniors address the other participants and audience at the commencement ceremony.

The student speakers may deliver a personal address of any nature so long as it is appropriate for the circumstances and is not disruptive to the ceremony. The school principal and senior class advisor may establish time periods to limit the length of the student's presentation.
