

Any employed or contracted school bus driver for this school district, who observes a violation of the law requiring all drivers to stop before reaching a stopped school bus with visual signals flashing, will prepare a written report on a form provided by the Idaho Department of Education indicating that a violation has occurred.

The school bus driver or a school official will deliver the report to a peace officer of the state, county, or city in which the alleged violation occurred within seventy-two (72) hours after the alleged violation.

The report will include the following information:

1. The time of the alleged incident;
2. The location of the alleged incident;
3. The motor vehicle license plate number;
4. A description of the vehicle involved.
